

ORDER

Effective September 3, 1996, enhanced security procedures will be implemented at Ali'iolani Hale, located at 417 South King Street, Honolulu, Hawai'i. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that access to Ali'iolani Hale will be restricted to strategically located security checkpoints only. Any person wishing to enter Ali'iolani Hale will be required to comply with the requirements set forth on the sign posted at each security checkpoint, to wit:

ALL INDIVIDUALS ENTERING THIS SECURED AREA ARE REQUIRED TO PASS THROUGH SECURITY SCREENING. ANY INDIVIDUAL REFUSING TO COMPLY WILL BE DENIED ENTRY. ALL BAGS, PURSES, BRIEFCASES, ETC. MAY BE SUBJECT TO A PHYSICAL SEARCH. ANY ITEM(S) DEEMED DANGEROUS OR HAZARDOUS SHALL REMAIN AT THE SECURITY CHECKPOINT. LAWFUL ITEMS WILL BE RETURNED TO THE RIGHTFUL OWNER UPON EXITING THIS SECURED AREA. UNLAWFUL ITEMS WILL BE TURNED OVER TO THE APPROPRIATE AUTHORITIES.
