ORDER AMENDING RULE 10.4 OF THE
HAWAI'I COURT RECORDS RULES

(By: Recktenwald, C.J., Nakayama, McKenna, Pollack, and Wilson, JJ.)

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Rule 10.4 of the Hawai'i Court Records Rules is amended, effective upon the filing of this order, as follows (new material is underscored):

Rule 10. ACCESS TO COURT AND ADLRO RECORDS.

10.4. Confidential Records and Documents.

Except as otherwise provided by statute or court rule or as ordered by (a) the court that has jurisdiction over a court case, (b) the Administrative Director or the hearing officer's designee having jurisdiction over an ADLRO case, (c) the court that has jurisdiction over an appeal from a court or ADLRO case, or (d) the supreme court, access to confidential records, documents, exhibits, and information shall be limited to the court and court personnel in the performance of their duties, the Administrative Director and [his or her]the Administrative Director's subordinates in the performance of their duties, the hearing officer, attorneys of record, parties to the court or ADLRO case, and duly authorized service providers.

Unless authorized by a court, an attorney shall not use the JIMS/JEFS database to gain access to confidential information under seal in cases in which the attorney is not a party or an attorney of record.
